

Rules for Category 3 - School Class

1. Age: 7-15 years. The age difference between partners must not exceed 6 years.
2. Pairs and groups perform a combined routine.
3. The maximum duration of the routine is 2:30 minutes; there is no minimum duration.
4. The routine consists of compulsory elements selected from the Pre-Youth Program tables and optional elements selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty or the appendix of the Pre-Youth Compulsory Tables.
5. Compulsory elements may also be chosen as optional elements, but they can not be from the same row used for the compulsory elements and must be selected from the difficulty tables (ToD) to clearly indicate that they are optional.
6. A free handstand must be performed by the top partner.
7. A maximum of 2 dismounts are allowed.
8. A maximum of 3 landings on the floor are allowed.
9. Each partner must present 3 individual elements.

WOMENS PAIRS (W2), MIXED PAIRS (Mx) MENS PAIRS (M2)

1. There must be exactly two obligatory balance elements, each selected from a different row I, II, III, or IV of the Pre-Youth Compulsory Table.
2. There must be exactly one optional balance element selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty (ToD) or the appendix to the Pre-Youth Compulsory Tables.
3. There must be exactly two obligatory dynamic elements, each selected from a different row I, II, III, or IV of the Pre-Youth Compulsory Table.
4. There must be exactly one optional dynamic element selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty (ToD) or the appendix to the Pre-Youth Compulsory Tables.
5. At least one of the dynamic elements must be a catch.

WOMENS GROUPS (W3), MENS GROUPS (M4)

1. There must be exactly one obligatory balance element, selected from row I, II, III, or IV of the Pre-Youth Compulsory Table.
2. There must be exactly one optional balance element selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty (ToD) or the appendix to the Pre-Youth Compulsory Tables.
3. There must be exactly two obligatory dynamic elements, each selected from a different row I, II, III, or IV of the Pre-Youth Compulsory Table.
4. There must be exactly one optional dynamic element selected from the FIG Tables of Difficulty (ToD) or the appendix to the Pre-Youth Compulsory Tables.
5. At least one of the dynamic elements must be a catch.
6. The optional pyramid can not be connected to the obligatory pyramid -> each pyramid must be set up and performed separately.
